

Participation terms Montana MUN 20xx

Zugerberg, November 2025

Venue: The Art Nouveau Aula at the Zugerberg, 1 hour away from Zurich. Extraordinary circumstances may result in the venue being changed.

Delegation size: maximum 8 students. Schools can indicate that they wish to send further delegates if there are spare spaces. Each Delegation must be accompanied by one or two MUN Directors.

Ages: The Montana MUN 20XX conferences are open for high-school students grade 7-12 (ages 13-19).

MUN Directors: At least one teacher / chaperone is required to accompany students as MUN Director. We do not accept students as MUN Directors / Chaperons, also not if they are of legal age.

Accommodation: Students are hosted in gender split 4 or 6 dorms. MUN Directors are hosted in single or double rooms, also split by gender. Bathrooms and toilets are generally shared. Upgrades are not possible. If you wish an alternative accommodation, please register for the option "without hosting and transportation".

Prices:

- With full board & transportation: Per delegate/director of CHF180, including 2 overnight stays at the Lucerne youth hostel, lunch Saturday-Sunday, dinner Friday-Saturday, breakfast Saturday-Sunday, and as well as transportation between the venue and the youth hostel.
- Organise your own accommodation and use the shuttle service from your accommodation to the venue: CHF120. For this option, the accommodation must lie on the route between the official accommodation and the venue. Please check with the Montana MUN Secretariat before booking your accommodation with this option.
- Without hosting & transportation: CHF95 per delegate/director.

Payments:

- Registration fee: CHF250, due May 1st. This payment will be deducted from the final invoice. Failure to pay the registration fee will result in deregistration from the conference. The registration fee is not refundable.
- Pre-registered (returning) schools are automatically accepted if they register during the pre-registration window and their payment reaches us by February 1st.
- Remainder of the participation fee is due August 20th. Failure to pay the registration fee will result in deregistration from the conference.

Opening ceremony / registration: Participating schools must attend the opening ceremony and to be by the venue well in advance to have time to complete the registration before the open ceremony starts.

Member State allocations: Member States will be allocated after the closure of Form II & Form III. Schools completing their forms and pay the full participation fee prior August 20th may request to have their allocation done earlier.

Refunds: Refunds of the registration fee or the full participation are generally not possible.



Conference cancellation: In case of a cancellation of the conference out of extraordinary circumstances, the organiser can only be held responsible for the payments received, which will be refunded. Additional expense incurred for participating will not be covered.

Selection procedure: The first half of the available places are given by a first come first serve basis, the second half of the available places based on the origin and type of school.
